

A HISTORIC COOPERATION

A historic three-century long cooperation, both at the diplomatic and commercial levels, which has consolidated over time with the ratification of a new cooperation agreement in December 2021. A partnership agreement on strategic sectors for both countries similar to agriculture.

Morocco's role as a hub of the African continent represents a real opportunity for British companies looking for new development opportunities based on win-win partnerships.

The agricultural production in the United Kingdom has given way over the years to the development of the industrial sector, which represents an important lever for its economy. Nevertheless, the agrifood industry is one of the most important industrial sectors of the British economy.

ECONOMIC AND AGRICULTURAL RECIPROCITY

The centuries-old relationship between the United Kingdom and Morocco is constantly evolving. An economic trade and agricultural relationship that is based on reciprocity.

- The UK is one of the top ten foreign investors in the country.
- Great Britain is Morocco's 9th customer and 12th supplier.
- Morocco is the UK's largest trading partner in the Maghreb.
- Nearly 10% of Morocco's exports to the UK are food products.

FOR A SUSTAINABLE FOOD SOVEREIGNTY

More than a decade ago, the concept of food sovereignty brought about tremendous reflections, debates and exchanges that challenged and contributed to the modernization of agricultural policies



Food sovereignty is not a series of technical solutions, but rather a process in action, an invitation for all, to organize and rethink together the way we manage food and agricultural production, distribution and trade, land use and water resources.

It emphasizes the multifunctionality of agriculture by referring to the right to food as a fundamental value and driving force of commitment. The concept of food sovereignty is part of a logic of sustainable development, associated with respect for indigenous cultures, socio-ecological know-how and agricultural resources. Addressing the challenge of food sovereignty calls for strategic and operational coordination to:

- Increase the value of local agricultural production
- Strengthen the social inclusion of farmers and workers
- Facilitate access to widespread social protection, improved rural infrastructure, better working conditions through technological tools
- Intensify efforts to strengthen the capacity of small farms for fair and equitable value sharing






















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
